To be considered for inclusion, submissions must meet our selection criteria as outlined in our [Resource Development Policy](#).

We also require the following information:

- Book Title
- Author's name
- Author's address
- ISBN
- Price
- Number of pages
- Type of binding
- Date of publication
- Publisher
- A brief summary of your book and its intended audience
- Purchasing information
- Any reviews from standard review journals (i.e. Library Journal, School Library Journal, Kirkus Reviews, Booklist, Publisher's Weekly, and Quill and Quire).
- Media and marketing information e.g., your book's website.
- Author's credentials - mandatory for non-fiction
- Why this book would be of interest to Kitchener Public Library customers
